Aging Population

"Aging Population" is no stranger to many countries nowadays, and it has become a serious problem. As we are now in the twenty-first century, our living condition has become a lot better. We not only have enough food to eat, but also enjoy better health care and medical help. Besides, we don't have to go to wars as often as those who lived 70 or 80 years ago. People simply live longer and healthier today.

But how could this be a problem for us if people can enjoy longer lives? To start with, as there are more old people in a country, the government needs to do a lot more to help take care of the elderly people. This means more nursing homes to be built, and more money to spend on health care. Also, too many elderly people in the country will bring trouble to the young, too. Because of the worries about money and extra time spent on their jobs in exchange for more money, young people don't want to get married or do not wish to give birth to children.
