Talking to your children about their feelings can be a good place to start. Using "***I statements***" is a good way to talk about your feelings. For example, "I've noticed that you appear to have a lot of things on your mind. I'm happy to listen and perhaps I can help."

Showing that you trust and have confidence in your children is also helpful.

Giving "positive messages" to your children lets them know that you care about them. For example, you can give them a hug or kiss to show your love or you can say "I love you" to them.

Every year, over six million visitors head to Munich, Germany, to take part in Oktoberfest. This is the world's biggest beer festival, at which over seven million liters of beer are drunk. There's also food, music, and dancing - usually on the tables in the huge beer tents.

The first Oktoberfest took place in 1810 to celebrate the marriage of Prince Ludwig. There was a big horse race during the wedding, and it was decided to hold another horse race the following year. By 1819, it had become a yearly event, and also involved beer drinking and farm animal shows. It was only in 1960 that the horse races stopped being a part of the festival.

Although these old customs are still kept alive, Oktoberfest has also become more modern. Since 2005, the beer tents have played music quietly until 6 p.m. so that the tents appear more welcoming and friendly. What's more, the beer tents have been non-smoking areas since 2010. Happily, these changes haven't affected the wonderful history of Oktoberfest, nor stopped anyone from having fun at this great event.
