The war on straws is growing as many people want to ban the use of plastic straws. Governments and fast-food

restaurants are working to reduce plastic <u>waste</u>. McDonald's has stopped giving plastic straws. Starbucks will stop using straws by 2020. Eco-friendly alternatives are available, but many of them have other problems.

Plastic straws are bad for the earth because they cannot be recycled. There are around eight million tons of plastic trash that end up in our oceans every year. Sea turtles are being found with straws stuck up their noses.

Two of the most common straw alternatives are paper and metal. Paper straws are still a single-use waste item and are not much better for the environment than plastic ones. Metal straws may conduct heat and they are also hard to clean as bacteria_can grow inside the straw. The best way is to go strawless as people will save the earth by reducing waste.

Shouting and waving flags for our favorite sports team are common for us, but not for the women in Iran. Women in Iran couldn't watch soccer games in public stadiums. They wanted to cheer for their favorite soccer teams or players loudly, like the men did. They even said soccer games shouldn't only for men.



Something happened in 2019. Sahar Khodayari was a big soccer fan. She wanted to cheer for her favorite team, so she dressed like a man and tried to get into the stadium. However, she couldn't enter it and ended up getting caught by the police. She set herself on fire to protest the law. The news shocked the world. It made FIFA take action and focus on the problem. They told Iran to allow women to watch the games in the stadium, or they couldn't host FIFA activities. Iran agreed. In October 2019, women were able to walk into a stadium and watch a soccer game for the first time for over 40 years.
