He told Tina not to <u>make a mountain out of a molehill</u>. "It's not a big deal. You shouldn't be angry about it," he said. As the days pass, Tina expects Ken to apologize; however, the apology never comes. In fact, Ken knows he made a mistake, but it's hard for him to say, "I'm sorry." He is afraid that apologizing will make him look weak.

Ken is not the only person that thinks that way, and that's why many people don't say sorry. Saying sorry doesn't make you weaker; on the other hand, it shows you have the strength to admit you did wrong and want to make up for your mistakes. When you apologize to people, they know that you understand their feelings, and your apology will bring you closer to them than before.

If you are not sure how to say sorry in the right way, here are some tips:

- * Do it in person and say it with words. Don't make excuses or say that other person is the problem; all you have to say is, "I'm sorry."
- * Don't put off your apologies. Say you're sorry as soon as you find your words or actions hurt others.
- * Apologies have to be real; they have to be from your heart. Say sorry because you want to, not because you have to.
- * Tell others what you might do differently to keep yourself from doing the same thing in the future. People make mistakes that hurt others sometimes. Apologizing isn't easy, but it's very important for everyone to learn how to do it right.
