If you never have a pet, watching cute animal videos is also good for your health and keeps you pleased as well.

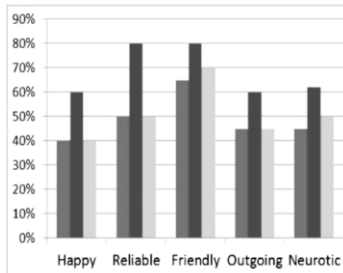
