

"So even though we face the difficulties of today and tomorrow, I still have a dream." - Martin Luther King Jr.

Martin Luther King Jr. was born on January 15, 1929. He is one of the most well-known civil rights leaders in US history. He even has his own holiday, every January 21. The story of how King became a great leader and improved black people's standing in society began in the American South.



Young King experienced racism, and so did his father. They were often treated poorly by racist white Americans. He made a white friend when he was young, but when the boy turned six, they were forced into different schools. At that time, black children could not go to a "white" school. King lived in the dark, and tried to kill himself when he was 12 years old.

Thankfully, King made it out of the South and graduated from university. He then worked in the church. It was here that he would begin to fight for justice. At the time, black people still couldn't vote, go to the same schools as white people or eat at many restaurants. One day, a black woman named Rosa was arrested for refusing to give up her seat on a bus to a white man. After knowing this, King began a series peaceful protests that finally changed many laws dealing with the equality of the blacks.

King also gave hundreds of speeches across the country. Although King was shot and killed on April 4, 1968, the work that he had finished changed a lot. He will be remembered for not only his performance but also his great speeches that moved so many.
