When Wilder died in 1915 at age 55, Elbert Hubbard, a writer, wrote an obituary to praise his positive attitude in the face of his disabilities. Hubbard wrote, "His was a sound mind in an unsound body. He picked up the lemon, and started a lemonade-stand." The lemon meant his disabilities. While reading this, is your heart filled with respect for him?

Among people born with disabilities, we see some of them totally fight back bravely, and some face it with anger and self-pity. What kind of life do you want to have? Your life is in your hands, not in the disabilities! Remember to live bravely and always try your best!


