美足男女國腳 協議同工同酬

Representatives for the men's and women's U.S. national teams signed their historic collective bargaining agreements with U.S. Soccer. The new contracts, which run through 2028, include equitable pay and treatment for appearances and tournament victories, revenue sharing and equitable distribution of World Cup prize money.

The U.S. women filed a federal gender discrimination lawsuit against U.S. Soccer in of FIFA prize money. American women received a \$110,000 bonus for winning the 2019 World Cup. However, American men would have received \$407,000 had they won in 2018. Now, the unions have agreed to pool FIFA's payments for the men's World Cup later this year and next year's Women's World Cup, as well as for the 2026 and 2027 tournaments.
